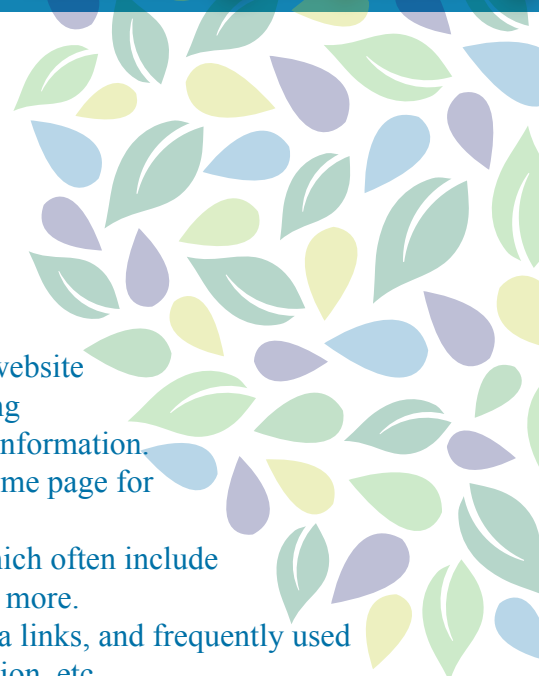


The Green Bay Area Public School District has launched a new responsive website enabling users to navigate the website on their desktop, tablets and mobile devices.

Tips to Navigate the Website

- A rotating image banner is located at the top of the District and school website home pages. The rotators may include links to important news, upcoming events, or photos. Clicking on the rotator images will take you to more information.
- News stories and upcoming events are located near the bottom of the home page for the District and school websites.
- On the right-hand side of all home pages, you will find Quick Links, which often include links to calendar information, forms, food service, Infinite Campus, and more.
- Each website has a footer that includes contact information, social media links, and frequently used links to Infinite Campus, community input form, facility rental information, etc.
- Across the top of the webpages you will find links to the staff directory. On the District website, the staff directory includes all District staff. When accessing the staff directory from a school website, it will only include staff who work at that school.
- Board of Education members, minutes, agendas and policies can all be found by clicking on the Our District link and viewing the left-hand menu of the District website.
- A link to employment opportunities can be found in one of four image boxes located at the bottom of the District home page.
- When navigating the website on a tablet or mobile device, the menu bar located across the top of the websites will be reduced to Menu, which will expand to the full list of links when selected.
- The District logo in the gray menu bar located at the top of school websites will return you to the District home page.

Important New Feature

The new website provides the District the ability to add emergency or important notifications on the District website or specific school websites. A red banner will appear above the rotator images on the home page(s). The District will use this feature to notify parents and community members regarding school closings or delays due to inclement weather, and critical or emergency information.
