Maintenance

- 1. Facility maintenance historically funded through operating budget
- 2. District intends to continue funding through normal budget
- 3. Act 32 Energy Exemption projects



Aged Facilities

- Many buildings over 60 years old
- Last fully new building completed in 1998 (Red Smith)
- Many facilities were built for a different time with different programming needs



Diversity of programming

- More programming occurring in buildings that were not designed to accommodate it:
- Social programs
- English as a Second Language learners
- Special Education Needs
- More personalized learning







historic enrollment










Projected Elementary Capacity – 2020/21
