facilities challenges

Identified Challenges:

- Elementary / Middle School Capacity
- Preble High School Capacity
- Baird Elementary – Obsolete and Overcrowded Building
- Leased Spaces (ELC, Head Start, John Dewey Academy of Learning)
- Spaces for Social Services & Community Interaction
- Modern, Flexible Learning Spaces that support more varied and personalized curriculum are needed
- Equity across the District

- Community centered facilities that bring together core educational programming with community partners, programming and support

Career and Technical Education High School

- Anoka-Hennepin (MN) School District - STEP – Secondary Technical Education Program
- Opened in 2002 in a new building on the Anoka Technical College Campus
- Program is intended to be “a middle place between high school and college, provides relevant education to prepare students for the high tech, high skill workplace of the 21st century.”



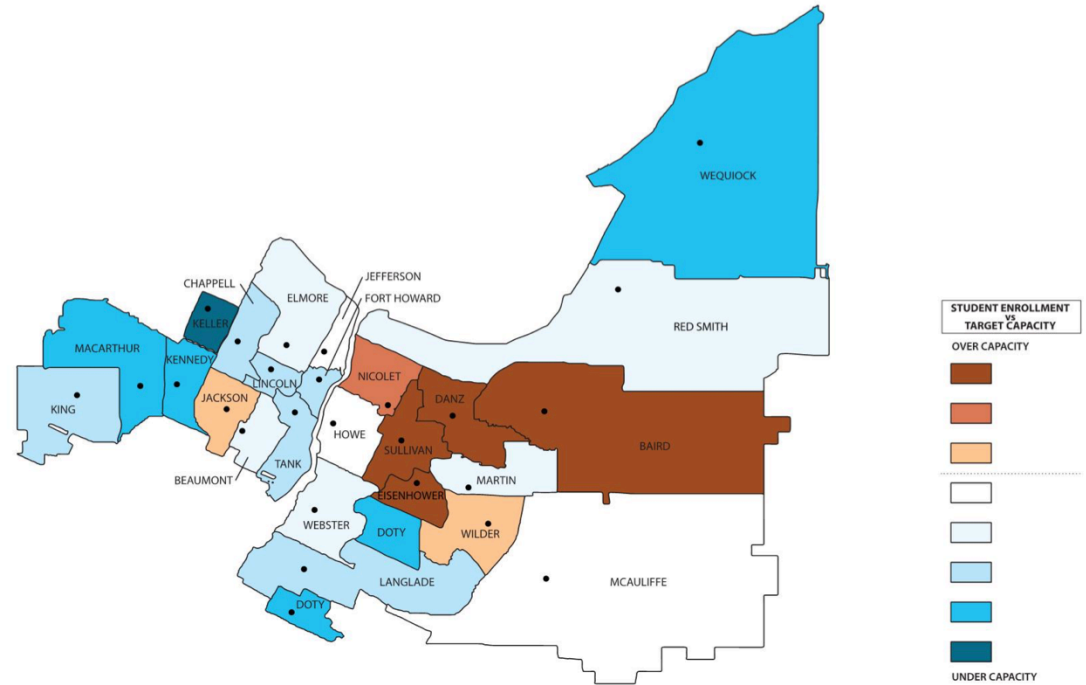

solutions opportunities

Challenge: Elementary & Middle School Capacity

Options

- Revise attendance area boundaries to rebalance
- Expand existing elementary schools to increase capacity where feasible
- Construct additional, new elementary schools to increase capacity in areas with crowding and/or anticipated growth
- Construct additional 4K-8 school (similar to Red Smith) to increase capacity for elementary and middle school
- Expand Edison Middle School to increase capacity

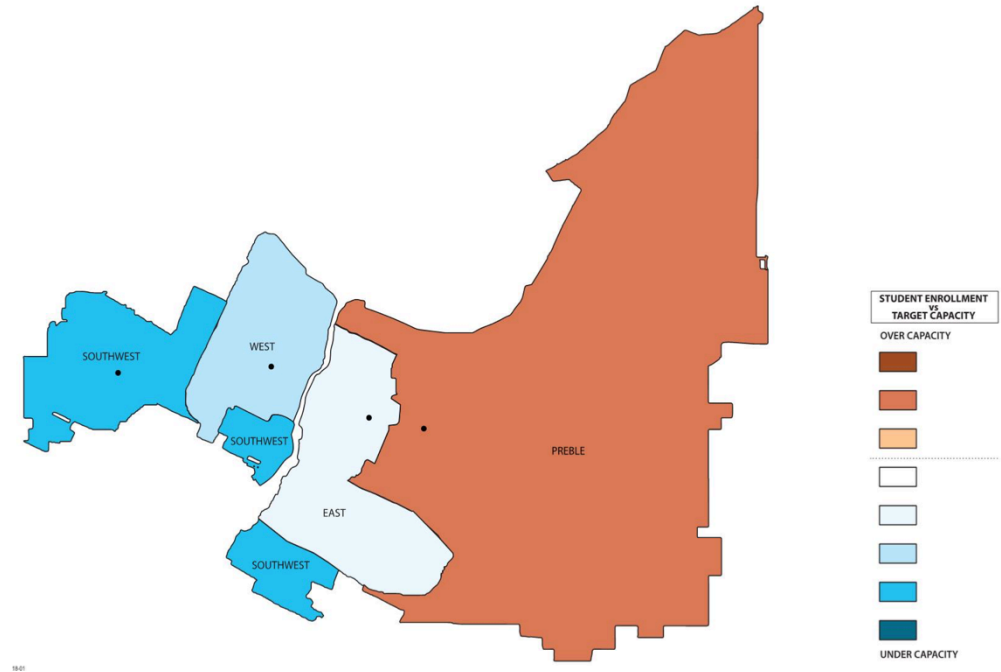


solutions opportunities

Challenge: Preble High School Capacity

Options

- Revise attendance area boundaries to rebalance enrollment
- Expand existing building to the extent the current site can accommodate to increase capacity
- Construct an additional comprehensive high school where population growth is anticipated
- Construct / develop a High School building and program that provides career and technical training allowing some students to spend a portion of their time outside of their home school (potentially reduce the number of students at Preble at one time)



solutions opportunities

Challenge: Outdated and Overcrowded Baird Elementary

Options

- Replace with a new 4K-5 building on the same site
- Relocate school to a new 4K-5 building on a different site within the Baird attendance area
- Relocate school to a new 4K-8 building on a different site within the Baird attendance area



solutions opportunities

Challenge: Leased Spaces

Options – Early Learning Center (ELC)

- Relocate to an expanded elementary school (possibly Martin Elementary)
- Relocate program to a new or renovated building centrally located within the District
- Relocate to a new Community School



solutions opportunities

Challenge: Leased Spaces

Options – Head Start

- Relocate programming to expanded elementary school buildings
- Relocate Head Start programming to a new Community School



solutions opportunities

Challenge: Leased Spaces

Options – John Dewey Learning Academy

- Relocate programming to renovated / expanded space at an existing Middle or High School
- Relocate JDAL to a stand alone building centrally located within the District (new building or renovated existing building)



solutions opportunities

Challenge: Spaces for Social Services & Community Interaction

Options

- Create / add a Community Room with supporting facilities to existing buildings
- Construct a new Community School to accommodate a variety of current and future programs
- Renovate spaces within existing buildings to provide proper facilities for programming (e.g. Dental Clinics, after school care)

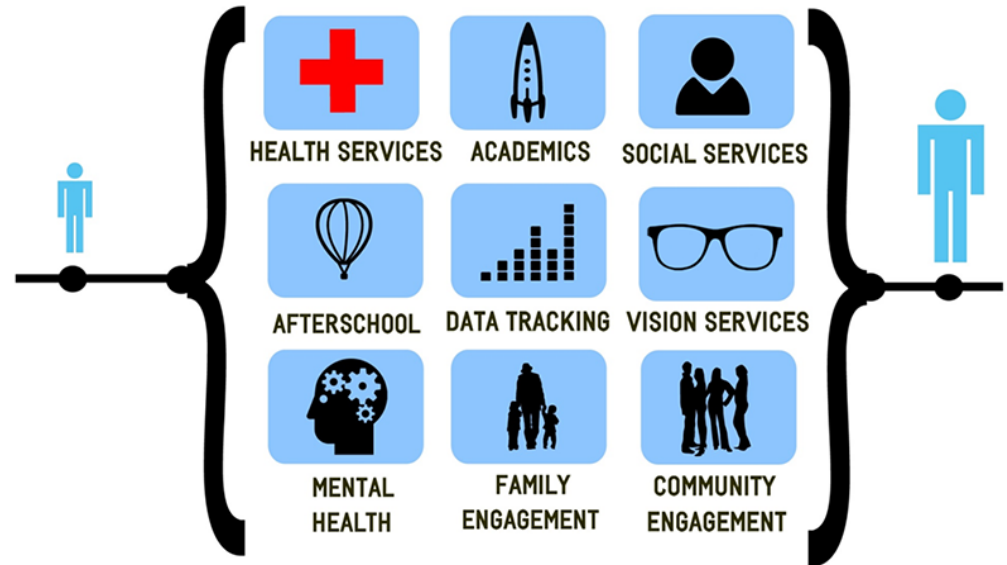

Challenge: Create Modern Flexible Learning Spaces

Options

- Renovate spaces in existing buildings to provide greater flexibility
- Construct additions to buildings where needed and feasible to increase flexibility
- Implement a program of investment in District-wide furniture and equipment replacement
- Provide appropriate facilities to support specialized curriculum (performing and fine arts, STEM,
