Panel members discussed the current state and the effect of the change in program structure. They also highlighted both the positives and concerns that they have heard from parents. Also discussed was the development of a more robust 6-12 secondary program for bilingual families and students. Discussed was the creation of a clear and concise pathway for students currently in the Bilingual program. The members of the council were in support of the proposed middle school pathway creation and implementation. Members of the council were concerned with the communication around the program and encouraged a more clear definition of what all of these changes mean. Concerns were raised regarding the current mapping of the district feeder schools and the possible lack of opportunities for students to continue bilingual education.
